Thank you for choosing the Temora Aviation Museum as a venue for your event. I am providing general information about the Museum for the benefit of your colleagues.

The Museum's Bunkhouses are not let to the general public however from time to time there are specific groups the Museum will make special arrangements for. The Bunkhouse costs and conditions do not reflect the standard accommodation arrangements of, for example, a motel.

I have attached a copy of Conditions for Bunkhouse use.

Other information relevant to your weekend's activities:-

- Access to the taxiway and apron area, via a remote controlled gate, will be provided to scale aircraft participants from 7am to 8am; participants are strongly urged to arrive between these times; any participants arriving later than 8am will need to phone Fabio Giacomini 0429 771 099 for access. Do not attempt to manually open the electronic gate. You must abide by Temora Shire Council's requirements if you are operating on any taxiways or tarmac areas.
- When models are flying – all sliding hangar doors are to be kept closed.
- Participant's registration includes entry to the Museum on Fri, Sat & Sunday (6-8 Nov). Each registration tag will include the exhibitor's name clearly written. Proof of identification will be asked for in the Gift Shop.
- All other persons associated with the NSW Scale Aircraft Society must purchase a weekend pass to enter the Museum's buildings and viewing area.
- Entry and exit into the Museum's buildings and viewing area is through the Gift Shop only.
- Dogs are not allowed on the Aerodrome; dogs may be kept on a leash in the car park.
