



## NOTAM 1 - 2010

Hello Scale Competitors,

Well, we are now all heading in the same direction toward making this event bigger and better than before. There have been a lot of changes, all for the better.

- 1) The Temora Council has constructed new amenities in the camping area. They consist of seven new showers and toilets, for both male and female.
- 2) The council has also built two new 2 bedroom apartments. We used these for the first time last year.
- 3) The Temora Aviation Museum will be holding their **SHOWCASE** day on the Saturday, 6<sup>th</sup> of November. This will last for about three hours, with full maintenance tours featuring pre and post operations for preparing aircraft to fly. The TISC believes this to be a win-win situation. Aircraft allocated to fly on our weekend will be the Museum's WIRRAWAY and MkVIII SPITFIRE, and Allan Arthur's P-40 KITTYHAWK. These aircraft will be performing flying demonstrations.
- 4) Tents will be allowed out on the hard surface apron as the council has made a swag of 55kg tie down weights available for use.



- 5) Models are able to be stored inside the museum hangar each night.
- 6) The flight judges will be moved 10m back from the grassed area so pilots using the grass runway will not be crowded.
- 7) Tents will be erected for model aircraft use whilst waiting in the ready boxes.
- 8) **ALL** full size aircraft have right of way.
