

## NOTAM October 2011

The T.I.S.C. committee has decided for the year 2011 that multi entries will be allowed in Team event, this is to encourage builders so the builder may enter more than 1 aircraft but must have different pilots, the entrant must contact the T.I.S.C. committee to get permission. We are now 1 week out from the event so the T.I.S.C. committee hopes that all those that travel please be safe on the roads and remember the event is all about fun as well as a high class competition.

- 1) To all contestants please review the rules prior to the event there has been no changes but please refresh
- 2) Entry to Airside will be through the Museum car park (top north) all vehicles must have a pass
- 3) No smoking or Alcohol Airside this is a federal offence. For those that smoke, exit through the museum gift shop to the car park and dispose of waste in correct area, no alcohol consumption by any pilot or helper during flying hours.
- 4) Major Pilot briefing on the Friday morning then short pilot briefing each flying day
- 5) Keep your area clean from scraps or spilt fuel
- 6) Saturday Museum Showcase all persons and aircraft will be in designated area
- 7) We will be hoping our new cross runways will be operational Temora council has spent a lot of money on this and the museum has continued the watering process
- 8) Flying will be still down runway 18-36
- 9) Transmitter pound will be in use for all TRANSMITTERS including 2.4 no exceptions
- 10) Council amenities will be open
- 11) The model aircraft can be put in the museum hanger overnight but no fuel can be left or the charging of batteries inside the hanger
- 12) Turbo prop aircraft will be classed as prop driven
- 13) In the interest of safety NO children will be allowed airside
- 14) **Only pilots and their caller/helper are allowed airside. All spectators must remain behind barriers.**
- 15) **All personnel airside must display a pit pass at all times or you will be asked to leave.**
- 16) **Over weight MOP certificates and MAAA card must be sited failure to do this will result in you NOT flying**
